Corporate Income Tax Extension

- * Massachusetts and North Carolina have waived late filing and late payment penalties, but interest will continue to accrue from April 15.
- ** While six states impose no corporate income tax, four of these states impose a gross receipts tax that applies to corporations: Nevada (Commerce Tax), Ohio (Commercial Activity Tax), Texas (Franchise Tax), and Washington (Business and Occupation Tax). Only two of these states (Texas and Washington) have provided gross receipts tax filing and/or payment deadline relief.
- *** Virginia has extended its payment deadline to June 1. Virginia has not extended its filing deadline, but Virginia law offers an automatic filing extension to all taxpayers for up to six months (or seven months in the case of certain corporations).

Sales and Use Tax Extension

- ^ The state will automatically waive late filing and late payment penalties, but interest will still accrue.
- ^^ The extension is not automatic. Businesses must request and be approved for an extension.
